


# Welcome to middle-income group, Azerbaijan!

- With annual average 29 percent of economic growth in just 3 years Azerbaijan has turned into a middle-income country
- To compare, countries on average spend about 11 years to become a middle-income country
- The size of the economy has tripled rising to the 81st place among 183 countries

### National income and social welfare



- Poverty reduced by 7 times in the past decade
- ■3.3 mln. persons was lifted above the poverty threshold


- Azerbaijan is 19th country in the world with the lowest poverty rate among 153 countries
- National poverty rate is 3 times lower than the global average (22%)

- Turkey 17.1%
- Georgia 31%
- Armenia 34.1%
- Tajikistan 53%

## Macroeconomic sustainability



- Azerbaijan is 16th among 142 countries in terms of macroeconomic stability (GCI)
- A 28 percent of deficit in 2003 was replaced with a 28 percent of surplus in 2012
- Strategic foreign exchange reserves comprise about 70 percent of GDP now


# President of the Republic of Azerbaijan, Ilham Aliyev has signed Decrees:

- On the establishment of the IT Development Fund (March 15, 2012).
- On the establishment of the High-Tech Park (November 5, 2012)
- "Azerbaijan 2020: The Vision of the Future" Development Concept (December 29, 2012)
- On the establishment of the University of IT (February 1, 2013).
- On the activity of an Electronic Security Center (March 5, 2013).



### ICT sector revenue

- doubled every 3 years (during the last 8-10 years)
- ☐ An average growth rate: 25-30%
- □ In 2012 the total revenue grew by 18% (1.9 billion USD)
- ☐ The share of the private sector: 80%







Azerbaijan launched its first telecommunication satellite on February 8, 2013.


Low Earth orbit satellite is to be launched in 2015.

Satellite's coverage area







## General information



# SITE – Evolution of Programs













